- Parents are encouraged to register and pay a deposit at the Largo Community Center, Highland or Southwest Recreation Center to hold a spot for their child prior to submitting a scholarship application. Space is limited in all Summer camps and they historically sell out.
- "Need" based scholarships will be offered until all funds are distributed or the camp is full.
- "Talent Based" scholarships are awarded based on an audition process and are limited.
- "Talent Based" auditions will take place by appointment on the evening of Monday March 27th.
- If approved for a scholarship, the family will be responsible for paying the remaining balance of the camp fees by May 13^{th.}
- A City of Largo Recreation, Parks and Arts membership card is required to register for summer camp. This membership is not covered under the scholarship funding.
